- Assessment by the FCPF Participants Committee



Assessment Framework

- Based on R Package Assessment Framework developed by FCPF Participants Committee (PC) in June 2013
 - Measures core readiness of the country
 - Self examination by REDD stakeholders



- Consists of 4 components and 9Sub-components
- 34 Assessment Criteria
- Diagnostic questions and guidance notes
